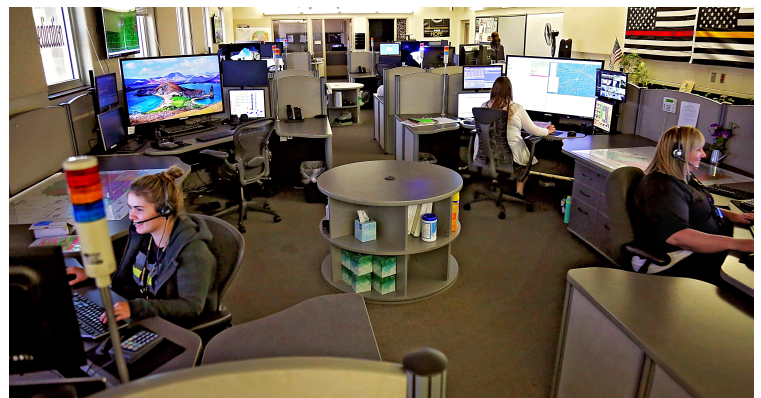
FISH invites you to learn about the Scott County 911 Dispatch Unit.



The 911 Dispatch Center is located at the Law Enforcement Center in Shakopee and serves over 152,000 residents of Scott County.

Operating under the Sheriff's Office Communications Division, there are currently 19 full-time dispatchers and 4 full-time supervisors who take an average of 250,000 calls a year. They respond to emergency and non-emergency calls for assistance and information and provide dispatch and communication support for all our cities in Scott County, including 9 law enforcement agencies, 8 fire departments, and 5 ambulance services. The Sheriff's Office frequently partners with Canvas Health, the mobile mental health team who work out of the Scott County Sheriff's Office to provide care, lasting resources, and ongoing support to individuals in crisis.

This division is also responsible for activating the Scott County Warning System and operates and maintains the 800 MHz radio system for all law enforcement, fire departments, and emergency medical services, as well as Public Health, Public Works, and public transit within the county.
