# Together We Can

Together We Can (TWC) is working with the community to strengthen families and prevent childhood adversity in Scott County, including current strategies to reduce risk factors and increase family protective factors.

They will also share more about their newly formed Parent Advisory Committee – a group of parents who help inform and support Family Resource Center programs and services.

Handle with Care, a program implemented in the Shakopee Schools, will also be introduced. This program has been implemented as a communication tool between the Shakopee police and the schools if a child has been present at the scene of a traumatic event. This tool or code allows staff to safely provide trauma informed care and maintain data privacy for the child.
